

SOUTH MORETON PARISH COUNCIL
Minutes of the Parish Council meeting duly convened and held on Monday 9th
December 2019 at South Moreton School

Present: Cllrs L. Deeley (Chair), W. Brown, R. MacDonald, T. Kendall and D Harland.
In attendance: L. Dalby (Clerk) and two members of the public.

1. Public Participation (Max 15 minutes)

The previous owner of the site reported that when he purchased it in 1993, he planted hedges to seclude the paddocks. The site currently houses three shelters, a trailer for tack and a caravan. The proposal is to replace all of these with one block incorporating four stables, a hay barn, lambing area and tack room. The plan is to tidy up the area and make it safer for the horses. Trees will be planted along the railway line.

Cllr Brown asked how the site will be accessed during the building as he had concerns especially if it is muddy.

The applicant reported that her access is on the track past the pub and she hopes to complete the work during the summer months though she will ask for permission from the landowner to use the other access to the site.
